WEEKLY CHALLENGE #1

Hello, members. This week I am presenting you with a challenge based on what was discussed in our previous meeting – HTML. That's right – you will script a small website based on the criteria that I give you on this sheet of paper. Participation isn't mandatory, but it is a lot of fun and shouldn't take much out of your time. Please feel free to share your work in our virtual meeting next week, which you should have another paper about.

Anyway, your challenge this week is to create a small online library. Really, it won't be much of a library, but listen up. You are to create a simple HTML website with at least 3 public domain* books (use Google!). There must be at least four pages on your website (including the index page), three different images, and one table. You may decorate and be creative with your site as much as you want, but please just get these basics down.

Remember! Include the following:

- At least 3 public domain books (they can be text files, word files, or even just in the HTML document itself)
- At least 4 different HTML pages (this includes your index file and your books if they're in the HTML file)
- At least 3 different images (they can be local or online and can be spread across your pages any way that you want)
- The entire website should contain at least one table

You do not have to include the entire book if you do not want to, but please include at least the title, author, and first chapter. As long as the book is in the public domain or is free to use, you should be fine.
